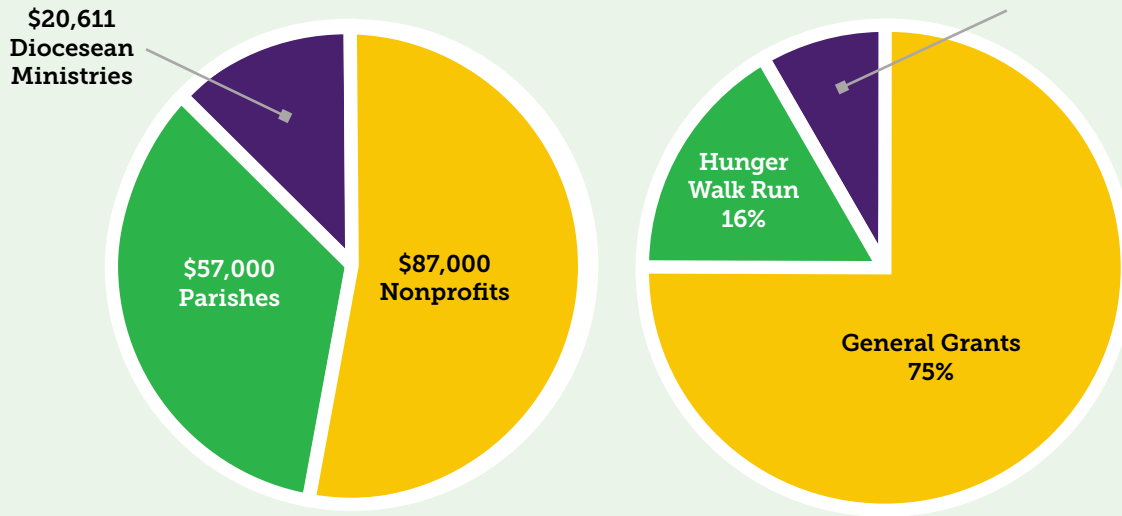


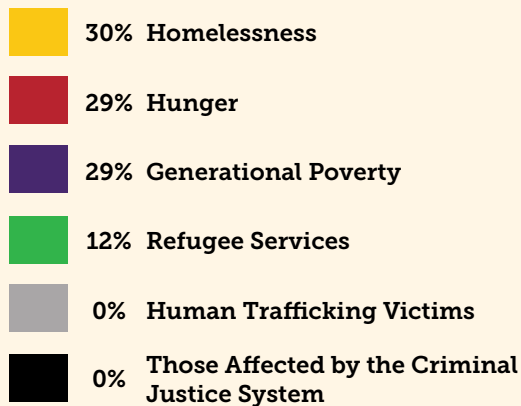

ST. PAUL'S (ATLANTA) BREAKS FUNDRAISING RECORD FOR 2019 HUNGER WALK RUN!

On April 28, ECF partnered with the Atlanta Community Food Bank for the 35th Annual Hunger Walk Run in its new location, The Home Depot Backyard at Mercedes-Benz Stadium. St. Paul's (Atlanta) nearly doubled their fundraising with an incredible \$18,595 and once again won the Bishop's Cup. Special recognition goes to St. Bartholomew's who came in second at \$6,685, and the following parishes who each raised more than \$1,000 to fight hunger in our Diocese: St. Benedict's, Church of Our Saviour, St. Catherine's, Christ Episcopal Church (Norcross), and St. Michael & All Angels.
